 - New mySNHU feedback from SGA Senators
 - Events page shows as a list and not a calendar view

 - Feels like everything is hidden
 - Academic Advisor contact information is not on main page anymore
 - Very easy to change preferred name and automated mass emails come through addressed to that name
 - IT ensured to have Brightspace automatically open on all classroom computers- faculty were having trouble navigating to Brightspace through the new mySNHU for staff/faculty
 - Course registration is hard
 - Many times the interface switches between old and new mySNHU
 - Online students who transfer to on campus have trouble understanding mySNHU
