 - Virtual/Remote Accessibility

- The executive board has decided to align with what the School of Business, SASE, and SETA are doing for all on campus classes which is only allowing virtual accessibility for those that are actively awaiting Covid test results due to exposure, have Covid symptoms, or are actively isolating/quarantining per the university's guidelines. If you have not checked your email recently, the isolation period has moved down from 10 days to 5 days. We will be allowing virtual accessibility for other medical needs with some extended parameters.
- The virtual accessibility guidelines are what all SNHU on campus classes have been told to follow, so the executive board has decided that this is the best course of action for SGA meetings as well. Everyone who applied for SGA this school year and has been in SGA pre-Covid, were made aware, and agreed to, the meeting commitments and those commitments, with exception to "virtual" Office Hours, are in person.
- RingCentral is being phased out by the university as of March 1st, so we
 will no longer have access to an every week link as we do now and will
 need to switch to Teams as our virtual platform.

Office Hours

- At the beginning of the academic year, the executive board stated that Senators would be able to have virtual office hours, so these can continue on a "virtual" format, this way we can decrease traffic in the SGA office.
- When you clock out of an office hour (unless you are scanning at a Penmen Pride Event) on Homebase, please "rate" the shift and then in the comments, write what you did during your office hours this way I can keep track of what tasks are being accomplished and making sure office hours are being used for SGA related purposes.
- For Senator's Office Hours, you are expected to either scan at a Penmen Pride event, work on a Special Topic and fill out an update, or work on an SGA related task for an hour. If you do not scan at a Penmen Pride event or work on/update me on a Special Topic, you must clock into Homebase and be actively working on SGA related tasks for an hour.
 - If you need help coming up with something to work on, I am more than happy to help you find something.
- Homebase typically has your shifts scheduled for you but if you are not doing a Penmen Pride event that week, it does not have a scheduled shift for you to clock into. Because of this, you can simply clock in at the beginning of your Office Hour and clock out when you are done.
